Mayor Scott Staggs called the meeting to order. Those present were: Tom Bischof, Donna Deardorff, Patricia Wilson, Michele Douglas and Robin Northern. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public comments: Debbie Johns with Van-de-Ven, LLC was present to go over the 2009-2010 City audit.

Dr. Nick Thiele with the Chamber of Commerce was present and went over events that are planned for the City of Bloomfield. Jim Mayo was also present and stated the Miller house renovations are still a work in progress.

Randy Supancic was present and reported the July 4<sup>th</sup> committee is working on getting the events together for this year.
